As Lord Mayor of Brisbane, Campbell Newman is drawing on his diverse experience to plan for Brisbane's future.

Cr Newman is committed to making Brisbane a smart thinking, easy living city. His top priority as Lord Mayor is to address Brisbane's traffic congestion by building new road infrastructure and improving the public transport system.
